

Bus Shelter

There has been no movement on dropped kerbs and no progress regarding getting the route reinstated. It is now very highly unlikely that this could be achieved before autumn and the worsening weather. This will mean another season of residents getting soaked and cold while waiting for the bus. The decision should be taken now if we are to have a chance of getting the shelter installed by about October.

Consultation should be carried out with the service users to find out which is their preferred location for the shelter. I can produce and laminate posters which can be fixed to the village bus stops, asking people to text, email or write to me by (.....date?.....) to confirm which one they prefer. I will ask for a name and address to prevent duplicates. Each bus stop could be allocated a number for ease of identification.

There is an amount of £2700 in the budget for the shelter, including fitting/installation. If Council agree to the purchase I can seek quotations up to that amount, including exploring the option of funding through advertisements and sponsorship.
