Thank you for your speedy reply and your consideration.

Basically, we want to provide all the school children with a selection box and residents who attend the event, a glass of mulled wine and a mince pie. Traditional festive refreshments basically. There are eighty one children on roll at St Bridget's, plus younger siblings and others that attend other schools, so around a hundred and ten in total @£1 per box. Six bottles of mulled wine @£4.99 and five dozen mince pies @£3.50 per dozen will complete the provisions.

Total : £157.44

I received our licence for the tree on Friday and we are making enquiries into our application for a Temporary Event Notice.
