

16. Working Parties & Task Delegation

There are a number of areas where it may be beneficial to delegate tasks to individual councillors or working parties. I have listed a few here, but the Council may think of some others:

- Play Park – Routine Safety Checks; painting; general housekeeping (not necessarily doing it, but arranging volunteers)
- War memorial – Weeding volunteers; cleaning
- Bins – Volunteers to empty
- Litter & fly tipping – Litter picking groups
- Beach Garden – Weeding; moving bits; general inspections
- Bowling Green – General inspection; Explore ideas
- Dogs – Dog warden contact.
- Football Pitch – General inspection & reporting
- Garages – Inspection & reporting
- Newsletter – Gathering Information; drafting articles; distribution
- Footpaths – Strimming
- Potholes & streetlights

By splitting areas up like this, we can cover the whole of the village. If every councillor volunteered to work on two or three of these, they could all be covered comfortably. The list could be advertised on the website, so people would know who to report problems to.

Council need to decide if they want to adopt a system like this and if so, which groups do we wish to include.
